Enock Carvalho is a director, screenwriter and producer with a degree in Communication and Journalism from Maurício Nassau University. He is also a founding partner of Gatopardo Filmes.

Matheus Farias is a member of the Edt. – Associação de Profissionais de Edição Audiovisual (Association of Audiovisual Editing Professionals). He holds a degree in Communication, Radio, TV and Internet from UNIAESO and a post-graduation in Cinema Studies from the Catholic University of Pernambuco. He is a founding director of Gatopardo Filmes and has 10 years' experience in editing, production, scriptwriting and directing.

Together they have written and directed three short films, "Inabitável" (Unliveable, 2020), "Caranguejo Rei" (King Crab, 2019) and "Quarto para Alugar" (Room for Rent, 2016), which have screened at upwards of 120 festivals worldwide, including Sundance, BFI Flare, Glasgow Short Film Festival, Frameline, Festival de Cine de Huesca, Busan International Short Film Festival, Durban International Film Festival, and Moscow International Film Festival, reaping over 35 awards between them.

STATEMENT

The story narrated in Unliveable arose from the surge of violence that currently ravages Brazil, the country with the highest homicide rates of trans people in the world. When we think about this almost daily repetition, which in turn is transformed into news headlines, we wanted – through cinema and through the power that film genre offers us – to tell a story of a character whose outcome is different than expected. Cinema allows this possibility.

In Unliveable, pain and fear are so profound that they crack open a fracture into reality, opening the door for the elements of science fiction to guide our characters in a direction that leads them away from death.
